<b>1.0</b>	<b>Planning Applications -</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a) 12 Marlowe Road (1 June) – Planning still not decided, comments on portal from Conservation Officer and neighbour at No 13 (attached)</li> <li>b) Cocks &amp; Hens Lawn Tennis Club (16<sup>th</sup> June) – this application may not relevant to our Area but there could be a concern about Biodiversity due to floodlights. Hugh to write to Guy Belcher the City's Biodiversity Officer s request a clarification.</li> <li>c) 18 King Road - This application is a concern and is being reviewed by members. It was confirmed that a neighbour who is a Council House Tenant has the right to object to a planning application,</li> <li>d) 109 Barton Road (17 June) – Large extension to form a 'U' from a 'L' shaped building. No major concern was expressed as the main issue maybe to the owner for loss of internal light to the property. No concerns yet expressed by neighbours or Barton Road RA.
